Safety Instructions for Contractors and Visitors

Life-Saving Rules



Obtain proper authorisation before overriding or disabling a safety device



Obtain a work permit before entering vessels and confined spaces.



Follow safe driving rules.



Verify isolation and de-energisation before starting work.



Control flammable materials and ignition sources.



Keep yourself and others out of the line of fire.



Plan the lifting operation and monitor the work area.



Work with a valid work permit where required.



Protect yourself against falls when working at height.

WHAT TO DO IN AN ACCIDENT

STAY CALM



1. Report accident TELEPHONE 112

- Where did it happen?
- What happened?
- How many casualties?
- What type of injuries?
- Wait for follow-up questions!



2. First aid

- Make the accident site safe
- Care for the injured
- Follow instructions



3. Further measures

- Direct the emergency services
- Move onlookers away

Action in case of fire Stay calm

1. Report the fire



Activate a fire alarm or call 112 anrufen

Where is the fire?
What is burning?
How much is burning?
What hazards?
Wait for follow-up questions!

2. Evacuate



Take endangered persons with you
Close doors
Follow the marked escape routes
Do not use the lift
Follow instructions

3. Attempt to extinguish



Use a fire extinguisher



In the event of an accident, your contact person must be informed.

Site plan and assembly points



Additional information

- Entering operational areas is only permitted when accompanied by your contact person
- Emergency exits, escape routes, fire-fighting equipment and fire brigade access zones must be kept clear
- Wedging or tying open fire doors is prohibited
- The work site must be secured with suitable measures
- Waste must be disposed of properly by those who generate it
- The site is under video surveillance
